Beijing's Public Security Bureau said that on Thursday, it arrested Wang Mingdao, an 84-year-old resident of the southeastern city of Jiaxing. The bureau said that Wang had been charged with the criminal offense of inciting subversion of state power. "Wang is the most hated man in China," the Public Security Ministry's Weibo microblog posted Thursday morning. "If you are Mr. Wang's friend, please immediately stop protecting him." It is not known how Wang became the target of the campaign, but his blog, "What is Delicious, Pleasant and Good," has been receiving tens of thousands of comments since its launch in May 2012, according to Google Translate. Wang has been outspoken about how he grows and sells mushrooms on his farm since 2000 and his

What's New in the AutoCAD?

Get to work! Hover the pointer over a drawing component to see the option to quickly add it to the drawing. (video: 0:23 min.) AutoCAD is expanding the rich collection of drafting symbols and other editing tools that allow you to design drawings quickly and easily. Just choose the one you want, place it on your drawing, and use the cursor to modify it.

Shape Editor: Draw quickly with the new shape editing tool. Just position the point where you want to draw, and begin to draw. (video: 0:37 min.) Draw using different tools with the new shape editor. For example, you can use a polar snap to automatically place coordinates along an angle, or you can use an offset arc to make a curved line. Draw custom objects easily with the new shape editor. You can draw custom objects, such as a polyline segment, using the same easy snap-based point placement that you have always used. Create custom objects with the new shape editor. With the new tools, you can quickly and easily create custom lines, circles, arcs, and polar lines.

Vector Glyphs: See and use glyphs as if they were components. You can now change color and move a glyph along a path, just as you would a component. (video: 0:25 min.)
